After a scoreless first half, the No. 8 Calvert Hall soccer team responded with two quick goals on its way to a 2-1 victory over No. 2 McDonogh on Tuesday.

Connor Walsh and John Tune scored for the visiting Cardinals (9-3-1) in the 51st and 55th minute, respectively. Mike Gamble was quick to put the Eagles (14-3-1) on the board and cut the deficit to one in the 60th minute.

Despite the offensive pressure McDonogh applied for the remainder of the game, the Cardinals prevented the Eagles from scoring again.

"It's a pretty big win," Calvert Hall coach Andy Moore said. "We got two early goals in the second half and McDonogh applied great offensive pressure, but our defense held and John Dillon played a great game.

Dillon made eight saves in the victory, while Mike Dunbar recorded both of the Cardinals' assists.
